Select one of the following topics and prepare an oral presentation in advance. You will present it to your class during the last lesson. Your presentation should consist of at least 15 sentences.

You may ask your teacher for extra words but please introduce these new words to your classmates before you make your presentation so that your classmates can understand your presentation. (you may distribute a word list or write on the board)

You may refer to your note occasionally but you are not to read from it.

Be prepared to answer questions by fellow classmates and your teacher after your presentation.

Topics: (Select one)

1. Tell about your travel experience.

Consider the following:

where you have been, how many times, who did you go with, how long is the journey, what impresses you the most, etc

2. Give us some information about China, or any country you like.

Consider the following:

where is it? size, population, weather, people, festivals, customs, habits, etc

3. Compare two countries (or places)

Consider the following:

prices, weather, people, food, size, population, customs, habits, etc.

4. Introduce yourself and you Chinese group to a new classmate.

Consider the following:

name, nationality if not Dutch, where he/she lives, likes/dislikes, single or married, what work does he/she do ...

5. Tell the listeners of 'Chinese Radio Amsterdam' about your Chinese study experience.

Consider the following:

why do you choose to study Chinese? how much time you spend studying each week? Is it interesting? how long have you been studying? etc
