

Learn to write

1. Take a good look at the highlighted radical of each character. Several characters have the same radical. Have you spotted them? Some of these radicals has very clear meaning which give a hint to the root of the character. Refer to the radical page in your book.
2. Look at the stroke sequence. Trace over and over with a pen until you are familiar with the correct sequence. Then, write the character using a writing sheet with a grid.
3. Pronounce the character and think of the meaning as you write.

Add the radical 'heart 心 xīn' to the word 你 and you get the character '您 nín', the polite form.
